Education and Skills

- Has experience of working with masculine identified persons. Shows an understanding of the particular issues that masculine identified survivors of trauma and childhood abuse face. Understands how current and historic trauma impacts survivors.
- Has experience of outreach work
- Comfortable doing public presentations
- Is committed to reflecting on their work using supervision and case consultation.
- Able to work in a demanding and sometimes stressful environment.
- Able to work well as part of a team but also able to self-motivate and self-manage.
- Qualification (Diploma or degree) in a related human/social service field or equivalent professional training and experience.
- Two years recent related experience. Or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience.

Role

To engage with youth who have experienced trauma. To raise awareness in the community of how trauma affects masculine identified persons. To promote and advocate for the Men's Trauma Centre in the community.

Key Duties and Responsibilities Outreach and Education:

- Participates in public education and outreach to raise awareness of masculine identified survivors of trauma including sexual assault and childhood abuse amongst youth 16-30. Supports/presents education to other agencies around working with this client group
- Acts a source of support and referral to masculine identified youth who come forward seeking help
- Consults and liaises with community service agencies to develop community relationships
- Is able to pro-actively promote inclusion to break down barriers for marginalized youth
- Maintains statistics, provides reports as required by the agency and funder
- Provides an annual program evaluation of the outreach program
- Attends relevant meetings as required by the agency
- Manage all admin tasks related to the role

- Attends supervision and case consultation on a monthly basis.
- Performs other related duties as required by the Executive Director
- To support other outreach work as directed by the agency

Other requirements

Willing to get or has a current Criminal Record Check.

Owns or has access to a vehicle that can be used for work.
